# South Branch School Council <br> Minutes <br> Tuesday, May 9, 2023| 1830-1930 <br> Webconference 

## 1. Acknowledgement, welcome, and attendance

Alan McKay, chair, South Branch Student Council (SBSC), called the meeting to order and a round of introductions were held. A list of participants can be found at the end of these minutes.

Steve lbbotson led the land acknowledgement.

## 2. Approval of the minutes from the previous meeting

The minutes from the April 11, 2023 South Branch School Council meeting were accepted as presented. The minutes are now finalized and have been posted to the South Branch Elementary School website.

## 3. Principals' report

Education Week took place May 1 through May 5, 2023. Although the Scholastic Book Fair has been rescheduled, other events took place including the open house on May 4 and the spring concert on May 5. Both events were well-attended and staff and students were happy to welcome families back to the school in-person.

Education Quality and Accountability Office (EQAO) testing will begin for the grade three and grade six students this month. Not all students will participate in the testing at the same time, and the test will be a mix of virtual and paper-based assessments.

Sexual education programming will begin in the next couple of weeks. Families were given 20 days to opt out of the programming, and encouraged to reach out to the school to discuss the format and content of the programming if there were any questions. Families can expect more questions at home about health and wellness in the coming weeks.

Field trips have returned, and a new feature to the field trip form in My Family Room is a medical consent form which would temporarily allow the supervisor/teacher of a student to make emergency medical decisions with medical professionals while caregivers in the case of a medical emergency while caregivers are being contacted/en route to the student.

The kindergarten open house will return in-person on Tuesday, May 30 from 1630-1730. The open house will welcome new kindergarteners to the school and staff and include a bus ride and meet-and-greet.

The 2022/2023 yearbook is currently being sourced and T. Preston is working with a supplier in Merrickville to produce the yearbook.

## 4. Teacher's report

The spring concert took place on Friday, May 5 and every class participated. This includes creating the visual artwork that was displayed in the gym and throughout the school for the event.

Teachers are currently working with the Municipality of North Grenville to come up with creative ways to encourage students to connect with the community and get more active and involved. One initiative is to have grade five students build birdhouses and then track which species nest in the birdhouses and track those birds in grade six.

Every classroom will participate in a field trip, and staff and students would like to thank the South Branch School Council and Tanya Preston and Pamela Sommerville for providing the funding and organizing the bussing schedule.

## b. Financial statements

c. Funds allocation

The field trip costs were approved in March 2023 by the South Branch School Council at an estimated cost of 600 dollars per classroom which totaled 10800 dollars. Now that all of the field trips have been confirmed, the actual cost is 7468.17 . South Branch Elementary School is able to put 2000 dollars towards the cost of bussing with a transportation fund. Therefore, the total field trip support required from the South Branch School Council is 5468.17 , returning 5331.83 to the free balance.
i. Grade six departure gifts

In March 2023, the South Branch School Council approved up to 500 dollars for the grade six departure gift. Now that a gift has been selected, the actual cost amounts to approximately 783 dollars.

## 6. Parents Reaching Out grant update

The SBSC application to the Parents Reaching Out (PRO) grant was approved at one thousand dollars in early February. The SBSC chose Apprendre Avec Moi and the workshop took place on Tuesday, April 18 from 1830-2000. The event was advertised well, and several families and staff members attended.

The grant provided 1000 dollars in funding, and all leftover funds will be used to purchase new French reading material for the library.

## 7. South Branch School Council bylaws project update

The SBSC bylaw subcommittee met in January 2023 to review suggested revisions to the draft bylaws and edit content as required. Revisions continued throughout winter and spring 2023. A penultimate draft that includes sections on roles and responsibilities, social media management, etc. is available for review here. The draft will be finalized over the next month and presented for approval in June 2023 with the expectation that the bylaws go into effect for the incoming South Branch School Council in September 2023.

ACTION: The South Branch School Council Bylaw Subcommittee will review/revise the bylaws one final time before presenting a final version for approval in June 2023. The review is due back to A. McKay by June 1, 2023.

## 8. Hot lunches update

The June 2023 hot lunch schedule will continue with Subway on Mondays and Gabriel's Pizza on Wednesdays. It is not clear when Mr. Mozzarella will reopen, but the South Branch School Council looks forward to continuing the partnership with that restaurant again in September 2023. The order will be uploaded to My Family Room on May 18 with a due date of May 26.

## 9. Fundraising update

a. Plant and Bake Sale update

The 2023 Plant and Bake Sale will be postponed until 2024. The number of volunteer hours required to prepare for, manage, run, and clean up after the event are beyond the capacity of the South Branch School Council this year. However, a very exciting alternative was suggested Plantables - an Ontario-based company provides potted vegetable seedlings to gardeners and can deliver directly to your home on a date of your choosing. 10 percent of all funds raised via this fundraiser would be collected and if the 3000 dollar threshold is hit, 36 potted seedlings are donated to the school which would assist with rejuvenating the garden.
K. O'Connor will run the fundraiser and promote it via social media and gardening groups in and around Kemptville.

ACTION: K. O'Connor will continue to promote the Plantables sale via social media until mid-June.

## 10. Book swap

The next book swap will take place on May 15,2023 . The May book swap will not be advertised to families; there are many cases of books to be distributed and no additional donations are required at this time. Volunteers will ask students to identify which books they'd like to see by writing them down on a flip chart, and a request for specific genres will go out in September/October 2023 to help refill the book swap containers with books students would enjoy.
